## **Rules & Regulations**

1. First Prize \$6, Second \$4 Unless stated otherwise
2. Entry Fees - \$1.00 Per Entry
3. Flowers for floral work need not be grown by the exhibitor.
4. Any plant material, bases, drapes, or accessories allowed unless otherwise stated.
5. Arrangements in all sections must fit within 80cm bench space. (Intermediate and Novice may be smaller)
6. The Judging of the arrangements will be according to the Australian Floral Art Association (AFAA) green book and the judge on the day
7. Judge's results are final
8. Enquiries and guidelines of the Classes below can be made to the Steward, contact above
9. All entries must be dropped off between 3pm and 6pm on Thursday 6th June 2024.
10. Entries can be collected on Sunday 9th June 2024 after 4pm
