- 1. All exhibits must be the work of competitor.
- 2. Exhibit must not be soiled or worn.
- 3. Exhibits must have been completed in the past 12 Months.
- 4. The same exhibit cannot compete in more than one class.
- Stewards will be in attendance to receive exhibits, in the A.J RUSSEL PAVILION, on:-SATURDAY 1st JUNE 2024 FROM 9AM TILL NOON. TUESDAY 4th JUNE 2024 FROM 8.30AM TILL 4PM.NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTRY FEE \$1.00 PER EXHIBIT
- 6. Receipts will be issued on entry and must be produced on Sunday afternoon for the collection of entries. NO ENTRIES WILL BE GIVEN OUT BEFORE 4PM.
- 7. NO RESULTS WILL BE GIVEN OVER THE PHONE.
- 8. Prize Money 1st \$7; 2nd \$5 unless otherwise stated.
- 9. Where a trophy or voucher is awarded, no prize money will be paid.
- 10. The MYRTLE LINDSAY MEMORIAL ROSETTE is awarded to the exhibitor with the most points. 3 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd and 1 point for 3rd; where applicable.
- 11. All classes must be strictly adhered to, if there is a class already listed, entries must go in that class and NOT in any class not specified, as no alternative classes will be made.
- 12. The novice class is for entrants who have not entered an entry in Needlework before.
- 13. Exhibitors, please make sure all frames are securely fastened and suitable for hanging.
- 14. Framed items to be judged on needlework only.
- 15. Prize monies are to be collected at the Secretary's Office at the Showgrounds after 3pm Friday 9th June 2023 & before the end of the show. Monies will not be forwarded. If exhibitor cannot pick up their exhibit or prize money (if any awarded) please make arrangements with a steward to collect exhibit/prize money on your behalf at the end of the show.
- 16. COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS: Stewards shall be in attendance from 4pm Sunday 9th June 2024 for exhibitors to collect their exhibits. RECEIPTS MUST BE PRODUCED
