CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

EXHIBITORS MUST PAY NORMAL ADMISSION FEE TO THE SHOWGROUNDS

1. Age of animal to be taken as of 1st June 2025.
2. All electrical equipment and leads are to comply fully with AS - NZS 3002 - 2008 and 3760 - 2010.
3. All entries to be registered with their respective breed society.
4. Breed, Name, DOB. herd book number or tattoo to be stated on the official entry form.
5. Any animal shown as an individual exhibit may not be shown behind its dam.
6. The Committee reserves the right to judge single class entries together or alter classes where appropriate.
7. All bulls over 12 months must have a nose ring and must be led by a nose ring and halter.
8. Bulls under 12 months of age and all females must have a nose ring or nose grips when being led.
9. All cattle must be thoroughly tractable and able to be led safely.
10. All cattle with the exception of suckling calves must be tethered with a suitable neck strap or chain, when not being paraded.
11. Cattle must be from a property on which Johne's disease has not been known or suspected to exist during the previous 5-year period.
12. All cattle must be free of ticks and TB.
13. Access is NOT PERMITTED into the shed or wash bay till 12pm on Saturday.
14. All livestock to enter via Gate 3 Beerburum Road Caboolture.
15. Breeds will be judged individually or can be changed at judges/Stewards descension.
16. Where trophies are donated this trophy will take the place of first prize money.
17. Unless otherwise stated First Prize \$15; Second Prize \$10; Third Prize \$5.
18. In accordance with DPI regulations all cattle must be scanned. Please ensure you have NLIS devices insitu & Property Identification Code (PIC) and National Vendor Declaration information on hand.
19. Caboolture & District Show Society will not accept liability for stock exhibited – the risk being that of the exhibitor.
20. Prize money to be collected at the Secretary's Office after 3pm on Friday 6th June until 5pm on Sunday 8th June. Any prize monies not collected by 5pm will become a donation to the Caboolture District P. A. & I. Assn Ltd.
