Rules & Regulations

1. **ENTRY DROP OFF & PAYMENT - Take your products to the correct pavilion, get the steward to stamp your entry form, then take your entry form to the show office and make payment.**
2. **SECTION LOCATION:** McLoughlin Pavilion (Building 3)
3. **ENTRY FEES:** Entry Fees: \$2 Adult, \$1 Juniors Per Entry Unless Stated Otherwise.
4. **ENTRIES TIMES:** Between 3pm and 6pm on Thursday 4th June 2026.
5. **PRIZE MONEY:** First \$10, Second \$5 Unless stated otherwise
6. Prize money to be collected at the Secretary's Office after 3pm on Friday 5th June until 5pm on Sunday 7th June. Any prize monies not collected by 5pm will become a donation to the Caboolture District P. A. & I. Assn Ltd.
7. **ENTRY COLLECTION:** 4pm Sunday 7th June 2026.
8. Overall Best use of Colour Trophy donated by Shirley Paddon (Life Member F.A.S.C)
9. Flowers for floral work need not be grown by the exhibitor.
10. Any plant material, bases, drapes, or accessories e.g. ribbons, glitter, lights etc. are allowed unless otherwise stated. Artificial flowers are not allowed unless stated.
11. Arrangements must fit within 80cm square bench space for Advanced and Open Section, Height unlimited. Intermediate and Novice may be smaller than 80cm but not less than 60cm square bench space, height unlimited, Children within 60cm square bench space, height unlimited.
12. The Judging of the arrangements will be according to the Australian Floral Art Association (AFAA) Manual and the judge on the day.
13. Judge's results are final.
14. Enquiries and guidelines of the Classes below please contact the Steward above.
