1. **ENTRY DROP OFF & PAYMENT - Take your products to the correct pavilion, get the steward to stamp your entry form, then take your entry form to the show office and make payment.**
2. **SECTION LOCATION:** Ben Johnson Pavilion (Building 6)
3. **ENTRY FEES:** Entry Fees: \$2 Adult, \$1 Juniors Per Entry Unless Stated Otherwise.
4. **ENTRIES TIMES:** 8am till 1pm Wednesday 3rd & Thursday 4th June 2026.
5. **PRIZE MONEY:** First \$10, Second \$5 Unless stated otherwise
6. Prize money to be collected at the Secretary's Office after 3pm on Friday 5th June until 5pm on Sunday 7th June. Any prize monies not collected by 5pm will become a donation to the Caboolture District P. A. & I. Assn Ltd.
7. **ENTRY COLLECTION:** 4pm Sunday 7th June 2026.
8. Fruit and vegetables exhibited in all sections are to be of good marketable quality and free of disease.

Apiary

1. All Entries are to be clear of all markings, stickers or identifications marks.
2. Honey is to be in One (1) 500g jar. Honey exhibited, in Classes 5062 to 5066 must be shown in the standard trade jar. Standard Jar - The jar is round (not panelled) and of clear glass with white top. It measures approximately 120mm with cap diameter 62mm and contains 500g reputed net weight of honey. Fill jars to 6mm from the top.
3. Novice Honey entries for competitors who have not previously won prizes at Caboolture Show.
4. Wax exhibited in Class 5069 must be shown in the standard shape and size, Standard 3kg Pail to be used for a mould, 1kg Block.
5. Wax Artistic 5070, up to 500g max total weight. Class 5071, 1kg max size, no bigger than full depth frame in space.
6. Candles Class 5072, entries are to be a total max weight of 500g. Bee's wax only no other waxes.
