1. **ENTRY DROP OFF & PAYMENT:** Take your products to the correct pavilion, get the steward to stamp your entry form, then take your entry form to the show office and make payment.
2. **SECTION LOCATION:** Russell Pavilion (Building 11)
3. **ENTRY FEES:** Entry Fees: \$2 Adult, \$1 Juniors Per Entry Unless Stated Otherwise.
4. **ENTRIES TIMES:** SATURDAY 30th MAY FROM 9AM TILL 12 NOON. WEDNESDAY 3rd JUNE FROM 8.30AM TILL 4PM. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
5. **PRIZE MONEY:** First \$10, Second \$5 Unless stated otherwise
6. Prize money to be collected at the Secretary's Office after 3pm on Friday 5th June until 5pm on Sunday 7th June. Any prize monies not collected by 5pm will become a donation to the Caboolture District P. A. & I. Assn Ltd.
7. **ENTRY COLLECTION:** 4pm Sunday 7th June 2026.
8. All exhibits must be the work of competitors.
9. **Exhibit must not be soiled or worn.**
10. **Exhibits must have been completed in the past 12 Months.**
11. The same exhibit cannot compete in more than one class.
12. Receipts will be issued on entry and must be produced on Sunday afternoon for the collection of entries. NO ENTRIES WILL BE GIVEN OUT BEFORE 4PM.
13. NO RESULTS WILL BE GIVEN OVER THE PHONE.
14. Where a trophy or voucher is awarded, no prize money will be paid. Unless stated otherwise.
15. All classes must be strictly adhered to, if there is a class already listed, entries must go in that class and NOT in any class not specified, as no alternative classes will be made.
16. The novice class is for entrants who have not entered an entry in Needlework before.
