1. **SECTION LOCATION:** Dining Hall (Building 5)
2. **ENTRY FEES:** Entry Fees: \$2 Adult, \$1 Juniors Per Entry Unless Stated Otherwise.
3. **ENTRIES TIMES:** Entries will be accepted at the Show Office starting from Monday 1st May 2026 till 5pm Tuesday 3rd June.
4. **PRIZE MONEY:** First \$20, Second \$15, Third \$10 Unless stated otherwise
5. Prize money to be collected at the Secretary's Office after 3pm on Friday 5th June until 5pm on Sunday 7th June. Any prize monies not collected by 5pm will become a donation to the Caboolture District P. A. & I. Assn Ltd.
6. **ENTRY COLLECTION:** 4pm Sunday 7th June 2026.

PRINTS:

1. All prints must be images taken by the exhibitor. Max Print Size is 500x400
2. Prints, including mount board, must be no larger than 50cm x 40cm or smaller than 25cm x 20cm. Junior/youth section minimum size is 15cm x 20cm. Panoramas will be accepted provided that the measurements do not exceed 60cm x 35 cm including mount board. Prints outside these measurements will not be exhibited.
3. The name of the exhibitor must not appear on the face of the print or border. **FRAMED OR GLASS MOUNTED FRAMED PRINTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Every print must be mounted on a stiff card with the Exhibitor's Name, Address, Title of print, and Class number of the entry printed in block letters on the back of the entered mount.
4. Exhibitors are permitted to put descriptive titles on the back of the photographs, particularly if this will assist the judge in interpretation of the subject matter.
5. A maximum of five (5) entries per section from any one exhibitor.
6. Prints previously won first place in the past 3 years can not be entered.
7. Entries will be accepted at the Show Office starting from Monday 1st May 2026.
8. Trophies, Prints and Award Cards not collected by Wednesday 10th June 2026 will be forfeited.

Computer Enhanced Manipulated Image.

Class 11002 Monochrome Print

Class 11004 Colour Print PEOPLE
(one or more persons)

Class 11005 Nature Print
Colour or Monochrome - depicts living untamed animals, insects and uncultivated plants in a natural habitat.
Evidence of the presence of mankind must be avoided

Class 11006 Animal Life and Pets
May include caged animals, birds and pets etc.

Class 11007 Landscape / Seascape

Class 11008 Colour Print
For non-camera club people who have not won a prize in a previous show or competition.
ANY SUBJECT

Class 11009 THE SHOW
A print depicting any Show activity.
Animals, People, Equipment, or function.
The print must be obvious in the showgrounds environment and can be colour or monochrome.
